 Petitioner's interest herein would be similar, but not necessarily entirely in accord with, the purposes and attitudes of that agency within the State of Washington known as "The Washington State Department of Game." Petitioner's said attorneys will not act as advocates for any of the parties to this action, but with the leave of the court, will present arguments and legal authorities on behalf of the fishermen members of the petitioner herein.

VI

Under the plaintiff's theory in the above-entitled suit, if
the Indians, who are residents of the State of Washington, are not
subject to the laws and regulations of the State of Washington as
regards the taking of anadromous fish and resident fish populations,
then said Indians would be in a position to make their own rules
and regulations for the taking of fish, or each Indian would be
an autonomous rule maker unto himself as regards the taking of any
fish presently under control by the State of Washington.

VII

Petitioner believes that fishermen as a class do not have totally adequate representation; that they would be bound by a judgment of this court, and therefore the court is entitled to know the views and attitudes of petitioner and that class it represents, and petitioner asks to be heard for said purpose.

WHEREFORE, petitioner prays that the court enter an order granting it the right to appear herein Amicus Curiae through its attorneys, and to be permitted to research, brief and argue the issues of the fact and law in the above-entitled case and to present memoranda and briefs in aid of the court, and for such other and further order as to this court may seem just and proper.
