Let the People Decide.

It is hoped that the monarchial ideas will not prevail when the Constitutional Convention fixes the salaries of the State officers. They should bear in mind that our government is Republican in form, and that the nearer the rulers can be kept to the people, in conditions and surroundings, the more stable will be the government and the happier and more contented the people.

It is sincerely hoped that, in fixing the salaries of the State officers, the Convention will not follow the rule proscribed by the Committee on Judicial Department, of fixing the minimum compensation of Judges at a rate about ten times as high as the wages of common labor.

What we want in the constitutional provisions for the new State, is authority for the people to regulate the matter of salary for themselves. We do not want a rate fixed which will establish an insuperable barrier between the people and their officers.
