requirements relating thereto, and the nondiscriminatory basis upon which reefnetting has been conducted since the late 1930s to the present date. Additionally, a certain amount of economic testimony will be given relating to the financial importance thereof to the participants and the replacement price of the necessary gear, as well as the sales prices, past and present, for partial or complete sets of used gear.

The Association will also, no doubt, join in and endorse the testimony of the anthropologically and economic experts obtained by the State of Washington, its Department of Game and its Department of Fisheries.
