3 the present date. Additionally, a certain amount of economic
4 testimony will be given relating to the financial importance
5 thereof to the participants and the replacement price of the
6 necessary gear, as well as the sales prices, past and present,
7 for partial or complete sets of used gear.

8 The Association will also, no doubt, join in and endorse
9 the testimony of the anthropologically and economic experts
10 obtained by the State of Washington, its Department of Game and
11 its Department of Fisheries.
