AMENDMENTS TO STIPULATED  
PRETRIAL SCHEDULE

9 Pursuant to a discussion this date with Stuart Pierson,  
10 wherein he advised that plaintiffs' counsel concur, and with the  
11 approval of the court, the Stipulated Pretrial Schedule dated 4 April  
12 1973 is amended as follows:

13 Paragraphs 18 and 19, as they apply to the Department of  
14 Fisheries, are amended to require the department to furnish its list  
15 of exhibits and to designate available deposition testimony on July 9.

16 Paragraph 23, as it applies to the Department of Fisheries,  
17 is amended to require the department to submit its written direct  
18 testimony for the biological and anthropological aspects of the case,  
19 together with its corresponding list of exhibits and designation of  
20 available deposition testimony, on July 9.

21 Paragraph 20 is amended so as to require the plaintiffs to  
22 serve on July 23, upon defendants, their response to the testimony  
23 and exhibits designated by the Department of Fisheries on June 25 and  
24 July 9.

25 It is understood that these amendments will in no way be  
26 construed to delay the trial of this action and do not alter other  
27 schedule deadlines.
