AMENDMENTS TO STIPULATED PRETRIAL SCHEDULE

Pursuant to a discussion this date with Stuart Pierson, wherein he advised that plaintiffs' counsel concur, and with the approval of the court, the Stipulated Pretrial Schedule dated 4 April 1973 is amended as follows:

Paragraphs 18 and 19, as they apply to the Department of Fisheries, are amended to require the department to furnish its list of exhibits and to designate available deposition testimony on July 9.

Paragraph 23, as it applies to the Department of Fisheries, is amended to require the department to submit its written direct testimony for the biological and anthropological aspects of the case, together with its corresponding list of exhibits and designation of available deposition testimony, on July 9.

Paragraph 20 is amended so as to require the plaintiffs to serve on July 23, upon defendants, their response to the testimony and exhibits designated by the Department of Fisheries on June 25 and July 9.

It is understood that these amendments will in no way be construed to delay the trial of this action and do not alter other schedule deadlines.
