After considering the motion of the defendant State of Washington to limit environmental issues, the plaintiffs response thereto, and the various written and oral argument thereto:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

- In the trial of this case, commencing August 27, 1973 and the orders based thereon, no affirmative relief will be entered against the defendant State of Washington on environmental matters, such as water use, water and air pollution, water diversion, watercourse alteration, land use, and construction of facilities, except to the extent that such environmental matters lie within the jurisdiction of the defendants Department of Fisheries and Department of Game:
- 2. Testimony and other evidence on such environmental matters will be accepted by the Court provided it is relevant to the issues to be resolved at said trial as stated in the Final Pretrial Order or is otherwise admitted by the Court in its discretion; and
- After the arguments of counsel are concluded and the 3. issues raised in the initial trial are submitted, the Court will consider, after notice and an opportunity for each party to present its views, further issues to be determined in the case.
