Cost—Inn:

Room and bath:

Two persons in a room\$3.00 per day

One person in a room 9.00 per day

Room without bath:

Two persons in a room 6.50 per day

One person in a room 8.00 per day

This rate includes three meals a day.

The charge for two persons in a room is for each person.

Lodge:

Room and bath:

Two persons in a room\$6.00 per day

One person in a room 4.00 per day

Room without bath:

Two persons in a room 4.50 per day

One person in a room 3.00 per day

This rate does not include meals.

The charge for two persons in a room includes both persons.

Cabins:

Furnished:\$3.00 per day

(May be one or two persons in a cabin at this rate.)

Unfurnished:\$2.00 per day

Individual meals at the Inn are as follows:
