## NOTES ON WHATCOM COUNTY BAR ASSOCIATION

Dawson, who has been on leave of absence from the Whatcom County Superior Court bench, during which time he has been in the Military Government service of the United States Army, is now home after an absence of two years. Major Dawson expects to assume his duties as judge early in December of this year.
